It is a professional non-profit organization with over 100,000 members throughout America, West Africa, West Germany, Bahamas Islands, Virgin Islands, South Korea and Italy. The sorority's ideals are scholarship, service, sisterhood and finer womanhood.

Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Omicron Omicron Zeta Chapter serves the communities in Gloucester County, New Jersey. The Amicae, one of the sorority's auxiliary groups are woman who assist and support the ideals of the sorority. These women promote public relations among Zetas and other women in the county. The Chapter also supports two youth groups. The Archonettes who are high school girls and the Amicettes, 9 - 12 year olds. The youth groups provide services and sisterhood to girls to the Gloucester County community. The Zeta Male Network is the men's auxiliary that assists all the women and youth in the chapter.

### Guidelines for Scholarship Applicants

Applicants must be a female African American senior who attends high school in Gloucester County, or a member of the chapter's Archonette youth group. Applicants must be planning to attend an accredited four-year college or university where they will obtain a Bachelor degree.

Awards will be based on academic, achievement, involvement in school activities, character, leadership, community volunteer services and career goals. Applications will be judged by the Scholarship Committee of Omicron Omicron Zeta Chapter.

**Items Needed:** A completed application consists of the application provided, an official school transcript, two letters of reference (one letter must be from an organization you have worked with on a service project) and an essay. Only completed applications will be considered.

**Requirement:** Recipients are **required** to attend a formal scholarship presentation on Saturday, April 9, 2022.

**Proof of Enrollment:** Recipients must show proof of enrollment by December 19, 2022 in an accredited four-year college or university before scholarship money is released.

**Deadline for submitting applications is February 19, 2022.** Scholarship recipients will be notified by March 1, 2022. Mail completed application to:
