Requirements: Recipients are <u>required</u> to attend the organization's scholarship event, which is to be held on Sunday, February 23, 2025, at The Sapphire Grand (formally known as Auletto Caterers), Almonesson, N.J. Recipients are also encouraged to invite friends and family to attend the event.

Award/Proof of Enrollment: The book scholarship is in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Recipients must show proof of enrollment by **December 31, 2025,** before scholarship money is released.

The deadline for submitting the application is January 1, 2025. Scholarship recipients will be notified by January 15, 2025.
